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HOME SCREEN



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



HOME SCREEN: WITH POP-UP ALERT

- We added pop-up alerts that are important for clinicians to review. These would be things such as:
 - tasks that need to be completed
 - vitals related to delirium that might be at dangerous levels
 - assessment that came back out of range
- We are using pop-up alerts with the intention of grabbing the clinician's attention as soon as they open the app, instead of having them browse through multiple screens before possibly finding important updates or reminders.



MEDICATION DETAILS

- We added extra information about the selected medication to help clinicians make informed decisions
- We wanted to prevent the clinician from needing to go to a different screen for that extra information because that could potentially cause them to lose track of the task they were working on.





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


OBSERVATIONS

 We added a section for mental status assessments on this screen because we felt it was missing, but necessary for clinicians to properly assess the patient.




DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSIS: POSSIBLE DIAGNOSIS

• We switched the color for the "Possible Diagnosis: alert from green to red. We felt it better matched the colors used in EHR systems that use red to indicate something that needs attention.



DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSIS: RULED OUT DIAGNOSIS

• We switched the color for the "Diagnosis Ruled Out" indicator from red to green to better match the colors used in EHR systems that use green to indicate something is resolved and no longer needs attention.
